

CRC Energy Efficiency Scheme (CRC)

CRC – Faros Solutions

All companies with at least one half hourly (HH) electricity meter will be required to register and disclose information as a minimum. Some organisations will have to fully participate in the scheme from compliance reporting to purchasing of allowances and as such our services encompass the full spectrum of requirements.

Please note the registration period is between 1 April 2010 and 30 September 2010 and this is also the period for information disclosure if you do not qualify for full participation. Being prepared for the CRC will help with budgetary requirements, raise awareness of the legal commitment and operational impact within organisations and ensure deadlines are met and thus penalties avoided.

Level One

Faros can help you assess your liability and legal responsibility by advising on **who** should be registering within your organisation structure and determining which of the following categories you fall into:

- Consume less than 3,000 MWh
- Consume between 3,001 – 5,999 MWh
- Consumption is greater than 6,000 MWh

Level Two

If the consumption from all HH electricity meters within your organisation is between 3,001 – 5,999 MWh you will be required to also submit the total annual consumption for the qualification year. Faros can assist with the compilation of the data and energy management advice.

Level Three

For full participants, Faros can assist with compliance; ensuring deadlines are met, submission of accurate reporting, information collated for the evidence packs and allowances purchased as well as cancelled on your behalf. Faros provide a fully comprehensive solution including:

Additional Services

Early Action Matrix (which is the sole factor in determining a position on the first year's league table) has two elements; AMR coverage and the Carbon Trust Standard or equivalent standard (i.e. BS EN 16001). Knowing what energy you use and when is vital to energy management and can assist with energy reduction. Faros are able to recommend AMR metering and assist with the roll out of AMR installations.
